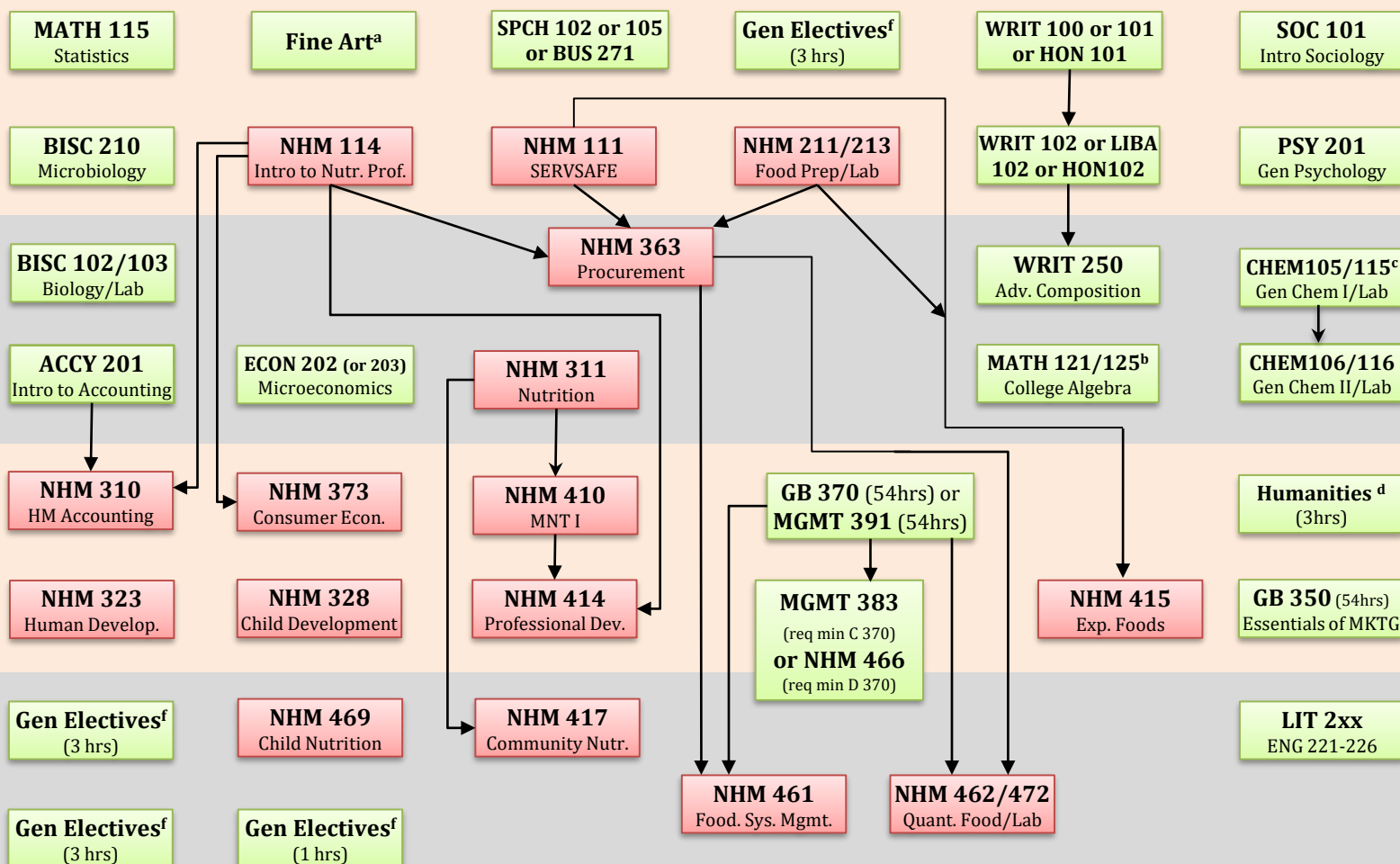

### College Requirements:

- At least 120 semester hours with passing grades must be completed for any SAS degree.
- At least one-third of the hours (40 hrs) applied toward a degree must be at or above the 300-level.
- At least 30 semester hours of residence credit must be taken in the school or college recommending the degree.
- An overall 2.0 GPA is required on all work attempted at UM, all college work attempted at any institution of higher learning (UM and transfer work), and all coursework submitted toward the degree.
- The limit on the acceptance of credit from a junior or community college is one half (60 hrs) the total requirements for graduation in a given curriculum.
- Each senior must apply for a degree by returning a completed Letter of Intent to Graduate Form to the dean's office by the appropriate deadline.
